## Why United States Marine Corps (USMC) Quantico?




- World-famous leadership training facility

### **Expedition Schedule:**

#### Thursday, March 30

- 1PM: Depart Sage Hall by bus for Quantico, VA
- Evening: Arrive at USMC Quantico. Training begins immediately upon entry into the base
- Overnight: Students sleep in USMC barracks

#### Friday, March 31

- Early morning: Training begins & lasts through afternoon
- 5:00-7:00PM: Reception
- 7:00PM: Johnson team departs USMC Quantico
- 1:00AM: Approximate arrival time, Sage Hall (April 1)

- All students MUST travel with the Johnson Expedition Team via charter bus to and from Quantico, VA
