

Expedition Schedule:

Thursday, April 7

- 1PM: Depart Sage by bus for Quantico, VA
- Evening: Arrive at USMC Quantico. Training begins immediately upon entry into the base
- Overnight: Students sleep in USMC barracks

Friday, April 8

- Early morning: Training begins & lasts through afternoon
- 5:00-7:00PM: Reception
- 7:00PM: Johnson team departs USMC Quantico
- 1:00AM: Approximate arrival time, Sage Hall (April 9)



Other Key Logistics





- All students MUST travel with the Johnson Expedition Team via charter bus to and from Quantico, VA
- Participants will receive 0.5 LSP credits – Satisfactory/Unsatisfactory
- Students <u>cannot</u> wear contact
