

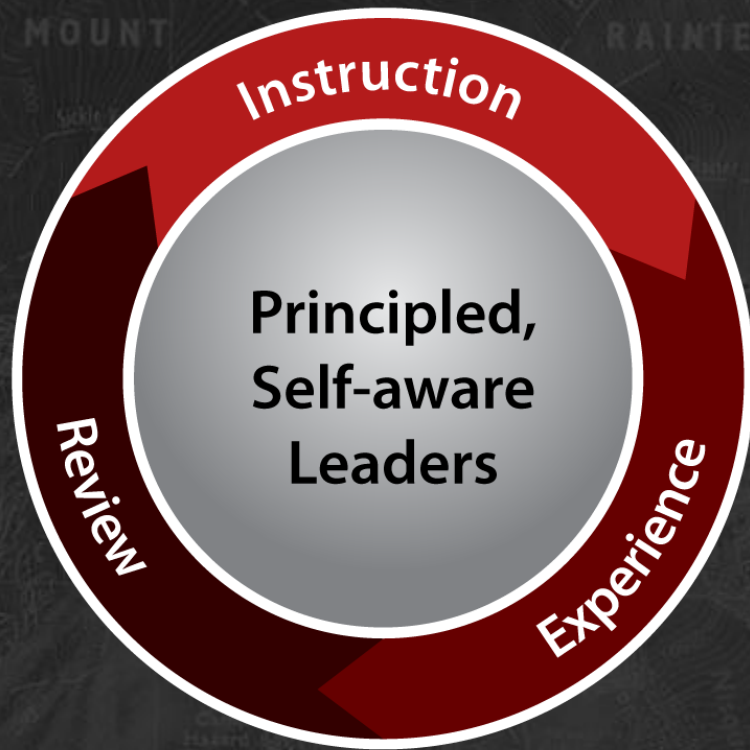

Why United States Marine Corps (USMC) Quantico?

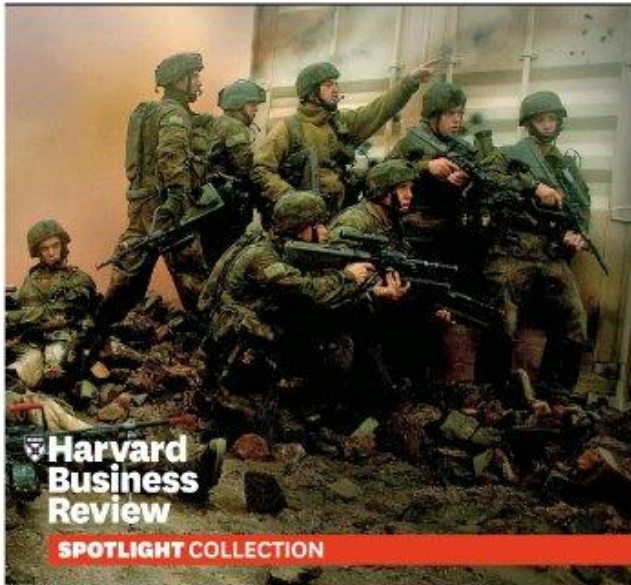


- World-famous leadership training facility

- The Marine Corps uses Quantico to train, evaluate, and screen officer candidates to ensure they have what it takes psychologically, morally, and physically to lead
- Every Marine officer has done the courses that you will experience on the expedition

Expedition Schedule:

Thursday, March 29

- 1:00PM: Depart Sage Hall by bus for Quantico, VA
- Evening: Arrive at USMC Quantico. Training begins immediately upon entry into the base
- Overnight: Students sleep in USMC barracks

Friday, March 30

- Early morning: Training begins & lasts through afternoon
- 5:00-7:00PM: Reception
- 7:00PM: Johnson team departs USMC Quantico
- 1:00AM: Approximate arrival time, Sage Hall (May 31)



Other Key Logistics



- All students **MUST** travel with the Johnson Expedition Team via charter bus to and from Quantico
- Participants will receive 0.5 LSP credits – Satisfactory/Unsatisfactory
- Students **CANNOT** wear contact lenses during the training; you must have glasses you can use in order to participate
- There is **no** student fee associated with this expedition
- Please note that if you apply to the expedition, you are committing to attend if you are selected
